March 1st 8-9pm "The Holy Spirit" a study on the Holy Spirit

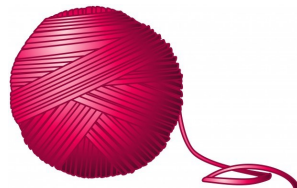
March 22nd 7-8pm "The Holy Catholic Church" A study on the church: visible &

Ujamaa Grandma's!!

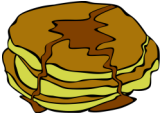
