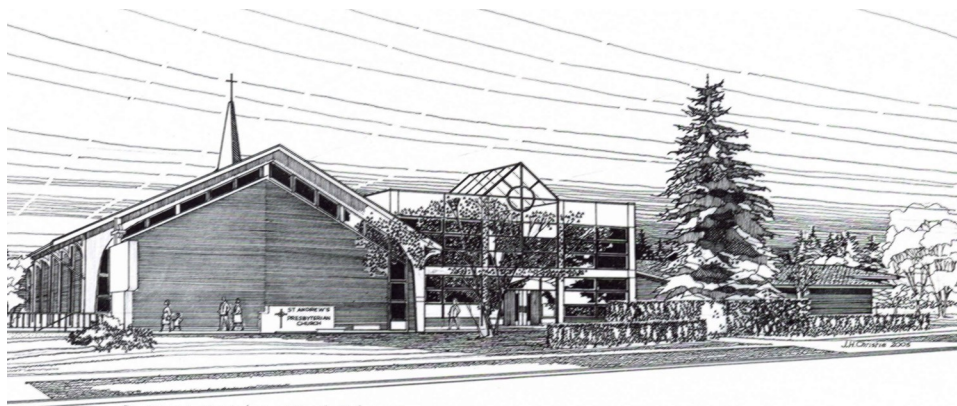

Stephen Ministry @ St. Andrew's

At St. Andrew's we think there is a need for special care of people in crises. There is a program called Stephen Ministry that might help us to provide this ministry. This ministry would depend on finding enough people with gifts including listening and faith, to visit one person once a week during a difficult time in their lives.

Stephen Ministry is a lay pastoral care program for congregations that equips and empowers lay caregivers - called Stephen Ministers - to provide high-quality, confidential, Christ-centered care to people who are hurting. The training program provides 50 hours of instruction in pastoral care. The format for Stephen Ministry then provides a way to manage and support you as a care giver in this ministry.

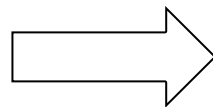

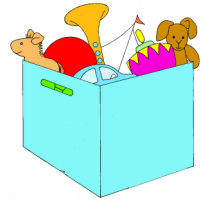


Christmas Bazaar – Kids Room
