Seasonal Flu is a respiratory illness caused by the influenza virus. Studies show that getting the flu vaccine reduces illness and spread to others.

Unless your Doctor advises otherwise, it is recommended that everyone from 6 months and older should have the flu vaccine.

It is necessary to receive the vaccine annually as the flu virus can vary from year to year and the vaccine is now available.

The flu vaccine is free if you live in Alberta and is offered by AHS clinics, through local pharmacies and family doctor's offices in all areas of the city.
