The teachers of the law muttered, "This Man welcomes sinners and eats with them." Then Jesus told them this parable:

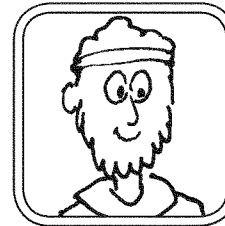
