What kind of funeral service do you want to have?* As with the first session, you will be provided with a take-home form on which you can communicate your preferences. You can take this form home to fill out. If at some point you would like to bring it to the church, we have a safe place where you can keep a copy so that any future minister will know what you would like for your service.
