From June 12-15, just ahead of the G7 Summit in Alberta, you're invited to the G7 Jubilee People's Forum in Calgary—a transformative space for Christians and justice-seekers in Canada and world-wide to come together, reflect, pray and take action for a just world.

The Forum will be held at Ambrose University from 7:00 p.m. Thursday, June 12 to Sunday, June 15 at 5:00 p.m. Highlights will include an interfaith worship service, a visit to Stoney Nakoda land for prayers with elders, hearing Indigenous and Global partner voices, Jubilee campaign training, and a creative public action in the heart of Calgary.

Through the support of the **Canadian Ecumenical Jubilee coalition**, efforts have been made to keep the event as accessible as possible.

It's also a key moment in the **Turn Debt Into Hope** campaign—a growing international movement, led in Canada by KAIROS, Development and Peace — Caritas Canada, The Canadian Council of Churches, Citizens for Public Justice, and the Office of Religious Congregations for Integral Ecology, to end unjust global debt and reform the global financial system. The campaign also addresses ecological debt—the exploitation of resources and lands in the Global South and in Indigenous communities worldwide.











By participating, you'll not only deepen your understanding of these global challenges, but also become part of a powerful, coordinated movement for change.

Together, we will:

- Build solidarity with the global Turn Debt Into Hope movement
- Explore spiritual grounding and moral courage in the face of this mounting global crisis
- **Call on G7 leaders** to take a lead in canceling unjust global debt and reforming the financial system to prevent future debt crises
