Ibrahim Atallah is a single father of a three-year-old son. Like many in Gaza, Ibrahim has struggled to find enough food to meet even the most basic needs. As the humanitarian situation worsened, access to safe shelter, water and food became increasingly limited.

In response, PWS&D, through ecumenical partners, has supported the <u>distribution of ready-to-eat meals and mixed food</u> <u>parcels</u> to families. These parcels help meet the immediate needs of individuals without access to functioning kitchens, cooking fuel or stable incomes.

Ibrahim was among the participants selected to receive this assistance. The food parcel eased not only his financial stress but also boosted the health of his young son. "This parcel will alleviate his suffering and provide my child with the necessary food," Ibrahim shared.
